Our first convert muslim lady, now is engaged to a wonderful brother in Christ and very soon we will celebrate their church wedding ceremony in Lome.

And since the beginning of COVID 19, Macklann's every morning devotion has drowned hundreds and hundred people in the gospel across the country and beyond Togo. At the end of every month he also leads night prayers. Devotions and prayers are sent out using WhatsApp on his phone. So from one group of 256 people, many that are receiving the devotions and prayers will also send it to their groups. *Isn't that amazing how God can use a phone app to bless many lives.* Feedback and responses come in every day, and because of that Macklann's schedule has changed a lot. Many appointments. He really enjoys meeting with people and praying with them especially in this difficult time of the pandemic.



Side note, Covid 19 is not a big deal in Togo (less than 200 deaths since the beginning) , but our government is so mobilized against the virus, which is a good thing, but people don't understand why they are not putting the same effort to stop malaria that is killing hundreds every day. Covid funds can be used to upgrade hospitals. Many Togolese people are really suspicious about vaccines and don't trust the gift if vaccines from Western countries. At the same time churches are closed again but markets where you can see pack people are open. Something is not clear.

Amana Conference



Since 2010 we have rented a house in which all was done during 6 years. Living space and ministries, like school, institute, house churches, meetings, and so on. That house is not really fit for school but we tried for many years to manage. The house actually is put on sale. We have negotiated with the Landlord to allow us to stay for 2 years, and we will see how the Lord will lead us. We are praying every day to seek God's will. At the same time we are looking for land to relocate the school and all the ministries. The land is found and we are negotiating for 40 lots. We have almost paid for 10 lots. We need you again.


You are among those who are helping to move on with the Kingdom and we believe you are going to help again with this big project (each lot is \$1,000).

At this point, as you know, we have 2 sites for AMN ministries. The main campus is the first place where we used to live, with 3 buildings in the same blocks at Adewui. And our house has changed a lot with classrooms. ***Thank you for helping with our house project.***

We have 270 kids in total and 30 staff people with \$ 7,000 a month USD, including rent, utilities and mission trips in Togo. With your support we have done a lot. The ministry is growing, especially with church plant in Lome at Basse's house and in Kpendjal extreme north of Togo with our church planter missionary Justin Assou.

PRAYER REQUESTS

- Pray for the long term place for all the ministries: the land in Lome suburban where we believe in 5 - 10 years is going to be urban and populated. Many people are relocating to suburban areas. 10 years ago our house location was farmland and bush. But today the place has changed a lot and the land is really expensive.
- Please pray for Basse family health and protection. We went and are still facing almost everyday spiritual warfare and attacks from many directions, even from family members. Macklann is the main target.
- Pray for our monthly support. Right now our PMI account is Zero. This month we couldn't receive full support because of lack of funds. \$2,500 short. Any amount helps.
- Pray for Macklann main assistant Bleck who is trying to receive a theological training at Covenant Seminary.
- Pray for Togo politics. We need God. Thy Kingdom come.
