Claude, Afi, Grace and Basile are doing well by the grace of God. Claude, our oldest boy, is also struggling with his studies. He wants to change his field from Sociological school, his passion now is Computer Science. Good news: Macklann's blood pressure is almost back to normal. Praise be to God.

Talking about the Togo Regions, one in particular is Kpendjal Region where our Missionaries **Justin and his wife Akoss** are in our prayers. Togo has been attacked by terrorists via North territory where Kpedjal is. Our church plant and school there are taking baby steps in a very difficult context. Islam is ruling families and you can imagine a church plant and Christians school among them. Please pray for Justin and his team.

Macklann's assistant **Bleck Sodji** is in Benin for theological training. Please pray for Bleck and his family as they go through this new transition.

In two months our ministry site location in Lome is going to be officially in the market for sale. We are the first on the buyers list. But without a down payment of 40,000.000 cfa or \$65,000 usa. The selling price is 120,000.000 cfa or \$243,000 usa.

Please pray for this and consider giving toward the purchases of the building where schools, institute, offices, and AMN meeting spaces are located.





Finally our farming ministry this year is affected by a poor rainy season. Most of the crops did not grow well because of lack of water. We are realizing that we really need to dig a well and install a pump that can irrigate the farm.

Please pray for this need and if you know any organization that helps to provide water for irrigation, help us connect with them.
