I started the new year with additional responsibility. Last General Assembly of the PCI (R) elected me as one of the coordinators (we have four coordinators: Chief coordinator, coordinator ministries, coordinator institutions and coordinator missions) and later on I was designated as Coordinator ministries which is responsible of looking after 17 pastors who look after 40 churches.
