At Timothy's graduation ceremony, we were surprised to learn from teachers that the song we had produced back in March for the school's missions week (https://youtu.be/JZ8CKgQGfgI) had been played school-wide every other week in chapel. The first grade class even choreographed their own hand motions to the song. We praise God for enabling us to participate in the school's ministry this way and we pray the song would have a positive, lasting impact on the students for Christ and his kingdom.

David recently led a session of our church's adult Sunday school class on spiritual disciplines (https://youtu.be/4C0VBAbwtYo). Toward the end of May, we participated in our neighborhood's yard sale, which provided unique opportunities to share our vision for ministry in Taiwan with those hunting for good deals who, in God's providence, happened to stop by our house. David also began meeting face to face with potential supporters (rather than on Zoom) and going door-to-door in our neighborhood as well, which he has wanted to do for some time, both to meet our neighbors and to share the gospel with them.
